New Salamis dominated the first period of the game, passing neatly whilst Colney Heath sat back under the pressure. Ryan Hervel & debutant Jordan Sanderson were pulling the strings.

Following a period of possession & quick interplay around the Heath box, a Heath defender stuck out a hand and no doubt it was a penalty. Kyri Portou dispatched the kick into the bottom corner sending the keeper the wrong way on 18 minutes.

The large crowd roared with approval, it was what the Reds deserved. Minutes later Harrison Georgiou was felled in the box, which again looked nailed on, but not given. Half time came 1-0 to the hosts.

The second half saw Colney Heath change formation but still with no real penetration, Deniz Mehmet had his shot saved, when he looked destined to score. On 73 minutes Harrison should have put us 2-0 up but missed from close range.

The reds were on top and Charlie Georgiou wriggled passed 3 defenders and when everyone thought he must score, the keeper saved. Minutes later Harrison wriggled through the Heath defence, and his chip shot was tipped over by the keeper.

New Salamis ran out 1-0 deserved winners & now face West Essex in the next round.

New Salamis Football Club History

New Salamis FC were formed in 1971 by fans of Cypriot club Nea Salamis Famagusta, with the Cypriot based club acting as a parent club to their fans in the UK. Playing in the KOPA (Cypriot Football League) a British League set-up for Cypriots in London, the club won countless honours and left the league in season 2017/18 as the leagues most successful team, winning 12 League Titles. The club also won a record 7 London County Cups.

In the 2015/16 season the club won the FA Sunday Cup, following a 1-1 draw with Barnes at Selhurst Park and winning on penalties. In 2016/17 the club lost to Hardwick Social Club on penalties again following a 1-1 draw, at Brammall Lane. Many of the players still play for the team today.

In 2018/19 we moved into the Herts County Senior League, playing our matches at Enfield Town FC. In our first season we won the presitgous Aubrey Cup Final, and also acheived promotion to the Spartan South Midlands League, after finishing runners up.

Season 2019/20 saw us participate in the Spartan South Midlands League Division One at Step 6, our ambition to achieve promotion to Step 5.

In March when the Covid-19 pandemic hit, we sat top of the Division certain of a top four finish and promotion. We also were the top scorers in all top 10 Divisions as the season was null and voided.

Last week we embarked on a new chapter winning our first ever FA Cup Match 1-0 vs Colney Heath FC, lets hope we can make more history tonight.

West Essex FC are based in Highams Park, East London. We are committed to providing affordable sporting activity for everyone in the local community. At the time of writing we run 5 adult sides, 16 Junior teams, our Kickers Soccer School and a girl's only team plus our SSE Wildcats activities across multiple East London / West Essex locations. Our playing membership across all these sections of the club stands at circa 450.

The brainchild of former West Essex Cricket Club stalwarts John Spinks and Richard Saunders, West Essex FC formed in 1989. After 4 seasons of considerable success in the Ilford & District League, an 'A' team was added for the 1993-94 season and the 1st & Reserve teams moved to the Essex Business Houses League.

In 2007-08, the 1st XI effectively folded and the club ran one senior side which finished rock-bottom of the EBHFL Division 1. Towards the end of that season, Gary Lefley became involved with the side. Gary forged a strong partnership with existing player/manager Dan Reading and their first full season together proved to be a very successful one as West Essex lifted the EBHFL Division 1 title in 2008-09. With success came an influx of new players and we were fortunate enough to reinstate the Reserve team who, under the guidance of Wesley Sotherton, won a trophy in their first season. The resulting celebrations culminated in them actually losing the trophy, but that's a story for another day.

At the end of the 2009-10 season, the management took the decision to withdraw the 1st XI from the Essex Business Houses League and move them to the Middlesex County Football League. The season that followed will live long in the memory as, in May 2011, it culminated with another trophy being added to the cabinet as West Essex were crowned champions of the MCFL Division 1 Central & East.

Promoted as Champions, in August 2011 West Essex had their first taste of Step 7 Football. Despite the season being blighted by injuries and suspensions, they finished it stationed safely in mid-table and took a few memorable scalps along the way. Further progress was made in 2012/13 as West Essex consolidated their MCFL Premier Division status with another mid-table finish, but with a bigger points total and a better record in all departments. Towards the end of the season new coach Kwame Kwateng joined with a view to adding some style to our obvious substance. 2013/14 was a memorable season for the club. Injuries, poor form and some appalling luck saw us staring down the barrel of relegation at the turn of the year. Thankfully, due in no small part to the tireless work of one of the most enthusiastic coaches around and a return to



fitness of some key players, a team which had such obvious potential finally started to deliver. A fantastic run of form saw us finish the season sitting comfortably in mid-table and emerging victorious in the Alec Smith Premier Division Cup final. Lifting the trophy was an incredible achievement for everyone involved with West Essex FC and that evening in Uxbridge will live long in the memory. In 2014/15, we continued to make progress by attaining our highest ever MCFL Premier Division finish of 6th. We also gained more points, scored more goals and conceded less than in any previous season. In 2015/16, with our ground-share agreement in place, we took the decision to apply for promotion from the MCFL. We didn't lose a game from August 8th until January 2nd which included a run of 11 straight wins. But we couldn't shake off our fellow title chasers and promotion candidates. Our second appearance in 3 years in the Alec Smith Cup Final, you might argue, was an unwanted distraction. We lost the Alec Smith Final on pens having been 2 nil up with less than 30 mins to go. On the coach back from the final, devastated as we were, a chorus of "WE'RE GONNA WIN THE LEAGUE!!" broke out, 14 days later, that is exactly what we did. After losing to New Hanford on April 9th, we took 23 of the 27 points available to take the title from under LPOSSA's noses. We were crowned champions of the MCFL Premier Division. In doing so, we guaranteed promotion to the Essex Senior League and a taste of semi-professional football for the first time in our short history.

Bringing things right up to date, the summer of 2020 will never be forgotten for a number of reasons, but it will be particularly significant in our history as it has seen the formal merger of our Junior and Senior Football Clubs into one 'new' club.

West Essex FC, as a new 'through' club now gives us a structured pathway for children aged from 4 years, all the way through to our Senior 1st XI and covers all related areas of community football. This new structure works perfectly with our club coaches who are active in the LBWF wider schools community, providing football activities in schools across the borough in the Easter and Summer Holiday Activity Programme.

Perhaps as important, is the bringing together of the key committee members of junior and senior football into one new and expanded club committee. This gives us the opportunity to leverage a vast skillset of our fully committed team, all of whom have incredible experience, knowledge and understanding of grassroots football. Mark Penfold, previously Chairman and founder of our junior football operation, now assumes the position of West Essex FC Chairman.






