Berlin Football Academy - Rule of Two Policy

The rule of two refers to the idea that a coach should never be alone out of sight with a player or child.

Two trained or certified coaches should always be present with an athlete, especially a minor athlete, when in a potentially vulnerable situation such as in a locker room or meeting room. All one-on-one interactions between a coach and an athlete must take place within earshot and in view of the second coach except for medical emergencies.

One of the coaches must also be of the same gender as the athlete for a female team.
