

COVID 19 RISK ASSESSMENT FOR TRING CORINTHIANS FC

Assessment covers all participants at all matches that are held at Tring Corinthians FC

Everyone to travel alone where possible, people from the same household or support bubble can travel together in the same vehicle, try to minimise the use of public transport.

Players and management to social distance where possible before, half time and at the end of the game

Players, Management and officials to be temperature checked on arrival, then hand they must sanitise before signing in to enable tracing.

Opposition to provide names of all players, management and officials on arrival, hand sanitiser to be provided.

If a player or anyone they have been in contact with is showing signs of Covid 19, they must inform the coach and not come to the ground, they must follow Government guidelines for isolation.

All players to arrive ready changed only changes to footwear allowed, players to take kit home to wash.

Changing rooms and showers will not be in use, toilet facilities one per team social distancing and appropriate hygiene to be observed, toilets to be deep cleaned after the match.

Players to provide their own drinks strictly no sharing.

Players to maintain social distancing with kit and drinks, all equipment and kit to be set out and collected by management one exception being the goalkeeper who will need to sanitise their gloves before the match.

Players are not to handle the equipment, when a ball goes out of play it should be retrieved by a designated club official not a player the official, this enables them to sanitise the ball.

All equipment to be sanitised after the match.

Substitutes, management and coaches must adhere to social distancing rules in the dugout and on the touchline.

Substitutes to warm up max three at a time but on their side of the technical area.

Players should not spit and should avoid coughing, shouting in close proximity of other players and match officials.

Goal celebrations with teammates should be avoided.

If there is an injury one designated first aider should attend, he is to be equipped with the correct PPE, all players should maintain at least a two-meter distance.

Referee to have the power to abandon the match if he feels the game is not being played in a safe manor.

Players to maintain at least a one-meter distance from the referee, getting in his face is deemed a sin bin offence.

Match fees to be cashless or in an envelope with cash that has been disinfected.

All matches to be behind closed doors until advised differently, committee members are allowed to attend.

Guidelines to be updated as conditions change.
