| <p>Busbridge lost to Waverley by 6 wickets. Tony Day was again in fine all-round form for Waverley. He was the most successful bowler on a damp wicket, but most of the Busbridge batsmen still reached double figures, with opener Keen top scorer. In reply, Day and Bower hit out well to give Waverley a convincing victory. They were supported by Harrington, Morton and Dexter. Edmonds and Mackey gave the Vandals a good start with 42 for the first wicket, but the later batsmen were unable to consolidate against tight bowling by Brewer and Harrington and they struggled to reach 114 for 9 at tea. Phil Burchett was in fine form for Waverley and attacked the bowling from the start. When he was dismissed with the score at 92 he had batted 64 minutes for his 67 with ten 4's. Peter Bower gave him useful support in a second wicket stand of 69 and the home side's total was passed with 6 wickets in hand.</p> <p>UNIVERSITY VANDALS: 119-4 dec. Edmonds 4-54)</p> | <p>Droxford lost to Waverley by 68 runs. Waverley were soon in trouble, Morton being run out with only 5 runs on the board. The runs came slowly against good bowling by Giles, and fine fielding, and only Day and Burchett offered much resistance. The tail wagged, however, and Waverley reached 115-9 at tea. Droxford were restricted by the Waverley attack and after the initial breakthrough wickets fell rapidly, a highlight being a first class one-handed catch by Bower. Haslemere eventually had a comfortable victory, mainly due to the batting of Richard Futcher, and the bowling of Barry Windebank and Arthur Whitcher. Haslemere began steadily, with Mick Mills and Malcolm Harris putting on 35 for the first wicket. When Futcher came to the crease, the runs continued to come and, although wickets fell at regular intervals at the other end, he was unbeaten on 81 when Haslemere declared at 184-8. Waverley began badly against the fine seam bowling of Barry Windebank and the spin of Arthur Whitcher, and only Kirkpatrick and Brewer offered any attacking strokes. | <p>Tongham lost to Waverley by 2 wickets. Both sides did well to complete this match in very wet conditions. Tongham lost half their wickets for 32 runs against good bowling by Kirkpatrick, but Sullivan and Cox came together to give a more respectable look at the total. Dexter finished with 3-3 in 5.5 overs. Waverley made a steady reply against tight bowling but when their eighth wicket fell at 68 they appeared to be in trouble. Gorringe then joined Parham and with sensible batting this pair saw their side home without further loss. Churt made a disastrous start against fine bowling by Kirkpatrick who took 4-12 off 16 overs, and lost 6 wickets for only 23 runs. But they made a good recovery with their last five batsmen all scoring well and reached a total of 103. Waverley, left with 35 minutes and 20 overs to make the runs on a slow outfield, were never really in the hunt against tight bowling. Kirkpatrick gave useful support as the home side were restricted to a total of 108. Waverley made a bad start, two wickets going down for 4 runs before Beck and Bodkin took the total to 45.
