A state-of-the-art new medical centre, including a GP surgery and pharmacy; a new primary school with a pre-school and playground that is fully equipped; a multiuse community centre with business units; a convenience store and café; and an opportunity for a care home.

Working with highway engineers to produce a cycle path and footpath, including a bridge for pedestrians and cyclists and improvements to the A389 Egloshayle Road Junction.



Land donated to Wadebridge Camels to develop another pitch as part of the open space for the site and a larger car park Superb landscaping, with native deciduous trees planned right at the start of the scheme across the area with traditional allotments/community food garden or orchard.



Leisure and tourism has been included with a park and cycle, with an extension of the Camel Trail. The extension will include a park and cycle area in partnership with Wadebridge Camels.

The Community Infrastructure Levy (Section 106 contributions) will be made for the benefit of the local community, although spend will be determined by the Council.
