

100 CLUB LOTTERY

As part of our ongoing fundraising activities, Abergavenny Rhinos would like to introduce the 100 club to raise funds as well as offering cash prizes for lucky winners.

What is a 100 Club?

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the Abergavenny Rhinos bank account and used to meet funding requests from the coaches, providing equipment, match kit, resources and opportunities for the players.

How does 100 Club Work?

- The 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, coaches and club members associated with Abergavenny Rhinos.
- For a cost of £3.00 per month (i.e. per draw) a member is allocated a number.
- The 100 club runs for twelve months starting in November 2020
- The numbers are put into a draw where a winning number will be drawn at the end of each month, with a single prize of 30% of the monthly money received from the 100 Club.
- The more people who join, the bigger the prize fund.

How do I join?

- 2. Payment is through monthly standing and will be requested through Pitchero.
- 3. You will then be allocated your number(s) and notified of this.
