Play fairly and be friendly Always show respect to everyone involved in the game Stick to the rules and celebrate the spirit of the game Always respect the Referee and coaches and encourage Encourage fair play and high standards of behaviour Play by the rules and respect the referee players to do the same Always respect the referee and encourage players to do the same Celebrate effort and good play from both sides, When players Never enter the field of play without the referees permission Listen carefully to their coach make mistakes offer them encouragement to try again next time Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive Be aware of the potential impact of bad language on others Understand that a coach has to do what is best for the team Have FUN, Stay behind the respect barriers at all times Be gracious in victory and defeat Talk to someone they trust or the clubs welfare officer if they Respect facilities home and away are unhappy about anything at their club Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language Encourage their team mates When working with players Place the well being, safety and enjoyment of each player Respect facilities home and away above everything Never tolerate any form of bullying Shake hands with the other team - win or loose Ensure all activities and suited to the players ability and age Work with others (e.g. officials, doctors, welfare officers, Respect facilities home and away physiotherapists) for each players best interests
