On and Off the field, at all club events and on all club social media platforms, they will:

Always show respect to everyone involved in the game

Stick to the rules and celebrate the spirit of the game

Encourage fair play and high standards of behaviour

Always respect the referee and encourage players to do the same

Never enter the field of play without the referees permission

Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive behaviour

Be aware of the potential impact of bad language on others

Be gracious in victory and defeat

Respect facilities home and away

When working with players

Place the well being, safety and enjoyment of each player above everything

Never tolerate any form of bullying

Ensure all activities and suited to the players ability and age

Work with others (e.g. officials, doctors, welfare officers, physiotherapists) for each players best interests

Play fairly and be friendly

Play by the rules and respect the referee

Listen carefully to their coach

Understand that a coach has to do what is best for the team

Talk to someone they trust or the clubs welfare officer if they are unhappy about anything at their club

Encourage their team mates

Shake hands with the other team - win or loose.

Respect facilities home and away

Always respect the Referee and coaches and encourage players to do the same

Celebrate effort and good play from both sides, When players make mistakes offer them encouragement to try again next time

Have FUN, Stay behind the respect barriers at all times

Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language

Respect facilities home and away

If they do not uphold their pledge and uphold our respect code of conduct, they maybe:

Required to meet with the club or league Welfare officer or CFA Designated Safeguarding Officer (DSO)

Suspended by the club from attending matches

Suspended or fined by the County FA

Required to leave the club

Asked to apologise to who ever they have upset

Issued with a formal warning

Dropped, substituted or suspended from training

Asked to leave the club

Required to meet with the club committee, league or CFA Welfare Officer

Obligated to undertake an FA education course

Suspended by the club from attending matches or have membership removed

Issued a warning or be asked to leave the club
