Apart from our new clubs, all our existing clubs will be familiar with the attached form.

It is to be completed **BY THE HOME CLUB** after every CCL match and emailed to myself (alanc52@aol.com) no later than midday on **Sunday** following a Saturday match, and no later than the following day for a midweek match.

The home club is responsible for advising the names of the goal scorers for <u>both</u> teams (first name or initial and surname please) along with the times of each goal, plus the match attendance which, for the sake of consistency, is the total number of people watching the game, excluding players and playing staff as opposed to only those who have paid.

The information is required for the weekly bulletin which will continue to be sent out every Monday (usually later in the day)

If away clubs wish to send in details of their goal scorers, they are welcome to do so but the onus is on the home club. Quite a number of away clubs do this and there is often a discrepancy between the two clubs with both names and times being different. Where that happens I will assume that the home club has their scorers correct and likewise the away club.

If home clubs do not obtain the information on the day from their visitors, they need to make a call or two to obtain the information required in sufficient time to send me the form by midday on the Sunday. If you send the form back to me marked not known in any area, you will be liable to a fine.

This procedure is entirely separate from the need to report the result immediately after the match through the SMS text system.

It is not compulsory to return a completed form if you have been playing in an "outside" competition, e.g. the FA Cup or County Cup but you are welcome to do so anyway, and all information received will be included in the bulletin.

As stated above, I prefer the information to be sent by email using the attached form but you can also send it by text (07956 930719) if that is easier for you, or even phone me up on Sunday morning (not too early!). You can also put the info in the body of the email rather than using the form if you wish, so long as it is clear.
