

CODE OF ETHICS AND BEHAVIOUR

Keynsham Hockey Club has adopted the England Hockey Code of Ethics and Behaviour. This is intended to provide clear guidance on the standards of behaviour expected of all our players, officials and others associated with our club including parents and spectators.

- In summary, all individuals involved in hockey will, at all times:
- Respect the spirit of fair play in hockey, not just playing within the rules.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others.
- Conduct themselves in a manner that takes all reasonable measures to protect their own safety and the safety of others
- Promote the reputation of the sport and take all possible steps to prevent it from being brought into disrepute.
- Protect themselves and others involved in the game from verbal or physical abuse and threatening or intimidating behaviour.
- Never use inappropriate language or gestures.
- Abide by the England Hockey Safeguarding and Protecting Young People in Hockey Policy and Procedures and Good Practice Guidelines.
- Abide by the England Hockey Equity Policy.
- Abide by the England Hockey Anti-doping Rules.
- Take personal responsibility to ensure that they are suitably insured for their activities.
