## 1. Accounting policies

#### **Basis of accounting**

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

## Depreciation

Depreciation of fixed assets is calculated to write off their cost or valuation less any residual value over their estimated useful lives as follows:

Clubhouse bar	13.33% reducing balance
Clubhouse changing rooms	13.33% reducing balance
Tractor	15% reducing balance

#### Stocks

Bar stocks are valued by an independent stocktaker, at the lower of costs and net realisable value. Cost is computed on a first in first out basis. Net realisable value is based on estimated selling price less the estimated cost of disposal.
