





## **Return to Rugby Update from our Chairman**

Welcome back to Rugby, sport and life. Let us hope this is the last lockdown we have to endure and we can crack on with the sport we love.

We are pleased with the response we have had throughout the club to return to Rugby especially considering what we have left of the season.

- The Seniors will start training immediately on Thursday April 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Minis and Juniors on Sunday April 4<sup>th</sup> (Easter Sunday).
- This is using RFU stage D regulations.

Fixtures are currently being sought for all club sections and we intend to take the training and fixtures through to the end of May.

**IMPORTANT** – whilst the RFU road map takes us to Stage D on May 17th where full contact is permitted, The Seniors, Under 16s and Colts we will not be training or playing with contact as it is felt that players will not be ready, which would heighten the risk of injury.

There will be some elements of contact from U9 upwards. The collisions at younger age groups are far lower impact. This will be introduced in a gradual and staged process to allow players to build fitness, technique and confidence prior to any adapted rules games in May. There are RFU guidelines on this process and guidance on contact time per training session.

**The café will be open on Sundays** through the double doors but no alcohol. Please give a warm welcome to Sandra and her team especially as it will be Easter Sunday on April 4<sup>th</sup>.











**April 12th**, we can serve **drinks outside** as long as you are seated, social distancing and with the rule of 6 applying. The marquee will be back and used as an outside space providing shelter for parents, coaches, spectators and players. From this date, the bar will be open on Thursday evenings for members social as well as for players that have been training. Drinks will be served outside, seated and obeying the rule of 6.

**May 17th** is what a lot of us have been waiting for. We can open the bar fully and serve **drinks inside** with rule of 6 applies, but outside, rule of 6 will no longer apply.
