PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- 4. Attend any required meetings of the 1st XV squad delivery team and be always the squad's representative. Ensure all staff are kept up to date with all 1st XV information and requirements.
- 5. Ensure with the Head & Assistant Coaches that the coaching and playing squad present themselves as ambassadors for Tring RFC and act in accordance with the core values of the sport.
- 6. Complete all appropriate administrative paperwork including all player registration detail from players, team sheets and other relevant forms prior to commencement of league programme.
- 7. Kit management pre, during and post training and match days.
