The sessions include:

- Physical competency assessments and regular field testing to achieve targets and meet the highest standards of performance.
- Speed, agility and movement based training to bridge the gap between the weight room and the sports field/court.
- Strength and power training that is specifically tailored to the levels of development, individual needs and abilities.
- Injury prevention strategies to develop physical robustness and resilience.
- Elite level coaches with the background to drive high performance standards and achieve the best results.
- Follow goal oriented programming every week and train with peers in an enjoyable, motivating and challenging environment.

These sessions also educate the young athletes about gym etiquette to build confidence in the weight room, nutrition and recovery to support performance and how to develop a training mindset for long term health and success.



Girls Only Youth Athletic Development

With the success of women's sport on a national level, our girls only athletic development sessions will support young female athletes to fulfil their potential whilst also reducing the risk of injury.

The girls only sessions will include all of the content from the youth sessions. In addition:

- > The sessions will support each individual based on their current biological age and level of physical competency.
- > Each athlete will be educated of the importance of injury prevention and how to manage their training schedule.
- Build confidence to utilise strength training and movement mechanics to cope with the forces experienced on the field or court.
- Build a training mindset for long term health in a nurturing, motivating and supportive environment.

Our youth athletic development sessions will be up and running on the 16th October. Sessions will then run every Monday.
