We want you to be able to find the right subscription and options whatever your circumstances:

- **Joining the club mid-way through the season:** If you are joining the club later in the season you may be eligible for a pro-rata subscription rate. Please get in touch with a member of the committee, or **email the treasurer direct** if you would like to discuss a reduced rate.
- **Dispensations:** If you find yourself in a position where you are having difficulty paying your subs, please get in touch with a member of the committee, or the **treasurer direct via email**, so that we can discuss options for dispensation with you.
- **Development:** If you are over 18 and new or returning to hockey, the 'training & development' subscription may be the right option for you; see above for the annual reduced rate, which includes all training (including development friendlies) and <u>excludes league fixture and summer league participation</u>. With that option, we appreciate that some members may accelerate their skill level quickly and their captain may recommend that they are ready to get involved in more competitive levels of hockey later in the season so if you later need to discuss extending your annual subscription to 'Adult full', please get in touch with the <u>treasurer direct via email</u>.

Driver reimbursement for away games:

For those who drive three or more players (including themselves) to an away game, petrol expenses are reimbursed at 25p per mile. This is calculated from the agreed meeting point (normally Salisbury Hockey Club but in some instances may be the driver's home, whichever is closer to the destination), to the opposition pitch and return.

In certain circumstances, there may be fewer total miles travelled if two players travel to an away game rather than seek to take a third. On these occasions, and if the other drivers agree, the total petrol expenses, calculated for cars carrying three players, can be split with the extra car.
