First Aid Equipment/Facilities	
Item/Location	
Each coach is always provided with an appropriate first aid kit to keep with them during training and match days. The first aid kits will always be with them at pitch side.	
A defibrillator is available on site, at Greystones, in the clubhouse referee's room. A second defibrillator can be found at the bowls club, which is located next to our 9v9 pitch. The clubhouse changing rooms double up as a first aid room if needed.	
Access Routes (How does an emergency vehicle/staff gain access to the ground/pitch)	
All pitches used for match days and training have vehicular gates that can be opened fully with no obstructions on either side. Whilst some gates are locked, as part of standard security processes, all our coaches have access to the keys for each gate, which are kept in the clubhouse at Greystones.
