ROLE DESCRIPTION

Director of Rugby

Overview from our Club's Coaching Policy:

Typically, a Director of Rugby (DOR) role combines high level coaching with a senior executive position, and is appointed with the remit to deliver a well-defined series of playing performance targets within budget, and with a predefined collection of resources.

The position is most frequently linked to club Senior Rugby sections, fulltime roles in secondary or tertiary education, or within senior clubs/regional/national governing bodies.

The Director of Rugby would typically take executive management responsibility for the delivery of Club coaching & playing policy, team management, player recruitment, coaching development, marketing, and administration of the club section to which they were appointed.

The DOR would report to the General Committee.

Key Responsibilities:

- **Develop and implement a coordinated coaching programme throughout all sections of the Club.**
- **Co-ordinating the implementation of the Club's "agreed playing philosophy" throughout all teams.**
- **Oversee the implementation and compliance of the RFU's Age Grade Rugby programme throughout the Club.**
- **To assume overall responsibilities for the club's Senior Section – assuming the role of Head Coach.**

Other responsibilities:

- Take responsibility for the recruitment and retention of players, coaches and management and developing and maintaining links with local schools and colleges.
- Provide succession planning to ensure that qualified coaches are appointed to all teams and receive the appropriate training required by attending designated coaching courses.
- Chair the Rugby sub-committee so that rugby policy is understood, properly disseminated to all levels and translated into practical action.
- Report to the General Committee on rugby matters and make recommendations on improvements/initiatives that need to be implemented.
- Set behavioural standard policies for all teams and members at the start of the season.
- Liaise with the Club coaches on matters such as playing facilities, equipment & playing gear.
- Be aware of all administrative procedures regarding player registration and eligibility.
- Provide training where appropriate
- To positively promote rugby at Saracens ARFC at all times – including through social media platforms.
- To engage with appropriate training as required.

Remuneration
