A new season, a new league! Following the protracted discussions, the RFU finally landed on the new 12 team league for Level 6 which means that the ONs for the new season are now in the catchily known REGIONAL 2 EAST MIDLANDS LEAGUE.

We have "lost" 6 sides from last season: Champions Bedford Ath are rewarded with a move to Regional 1 South East, of the other promoted sides Derby are in Regional 1 Midlands, while West Bridgford are moving to Regional 1 North East. Oadby Wyggs & Belgrave are both still at Level 6 in Regional 2 North Midlands, while Dronfield are in Regional 2 North East.

Staying with us are Towcestrians, Kettering, Lutterworth, Market Harborough, Olney & both Peterborough clubs. While joining us are Leighton Buzzard, returning to the Midlands after a sabbatical in the London Leagues, while near neighbours Northampton Old Scouts are promoted from Level 7. Finally to make up the 12 are two Warwickshire clubs "level transferred" from West Midlands to the East: Old Laurentians & today's visitors Newbold on Avon.

So the RFU have achieved their objective of less travelling, we've encountered all these clubs in the league in the past with the exception of Old Laurentians from Rugby. The League looks to be very strong & highly competitive, I'm sure we'll see some great promotion & relegation battles.
