

EMERGENCY REPORTING AND EVACUATION PROCEDURE

Types of emergencies to be reported by site personnel are:

- Medical
- Fire

MEDICAL EMERGENCY

Call medical emergency phone number 999

- Ambulance
- Fire

Provide the following information

- Nature of medical emergency
- Location of the emergency (address, location in park)
- Your name, number, first aid provided.
- Do not move the victim unless absolutely necessary
- Call the following trained in CPR and First Aid to provide the required assistance prior to the arrival of the emergency services

FIRE EMERGENCY

When fire is discovered:

- Notify the local Fire department by calling 999
- Notify the site personnel about the fire

Fight the fire ONLY If:

- The Fire department has been notified
- The fire is small and is not spreading to other areas
- Escaping the area is possible by backing up to the nearest exit.
- The fire extinguisher is in working condition and personnel are trained to use it.
