



## **STANWAY ROVERS FC MATCHDAYS**

### *UNDER COVID RESTRICTIONS*

We welcome you to The Hawthorns. Whilst we return to football in these unsure times the way in which we operate is a different to normal, please read so you know what to expect. We take our responsibility as a club very seriously and know you will feel the same, we ask that you follow the guidelines and instructions that given. #### TEAMS AND STAFF

Track and trace: visiting teams should provide a squad sheet with all players and support staff on arrival to the Hawthorns. Any player or staff member showing or declaring signs and/or symptoms of Covid-19 will not be permitted entry. Temperature checks will take place prior to entry.

Changing rooms: changing rooms will be available to groups of no more than six when changing. The storing of kit bags and personal belongings will continue. Team talks may be held within the changing rooms but limited to the starting 11 only. A sanitiser station will be situated at the pitch entrance for use by both teams.

Water bottles: players to provide their own water bottle – for personal use only.

Dugouts: Managers, coaches and substitutes should adhere to social distancing guidelines during play. Players to wear face coverings when not on the pitch.

Match equipment: goals, match balls, corner flags and substitute boards are to be sanitised before, half time and end of match.

#### SPECTATORS

Admission: entry to the club will be via the emergency vehicle access (on the far right of the car park) not the usual turnstiles route and the exit will be by the toilets as usual. Upon entry all spectators will be required to provide their name and contact number for the purposes of track and trace only, this will be taken by a club official. We currently do not have the facility for contactless pay and request spectators to bring correct entrance fees, where possible.

Staying safe: upon entry all spectators will have a temperature check. Hand sanitiser stations will be located upon entry to the ground and the clubhouse, as well as soap water and drying facilities provided in toilets. We are operating a one-way system both within the ground (anti-clockwise) and within the clubhouse (marked), we request everyone adhere to these measures and observe social distancing in line with government guidelines. Spectators are encouraged to bring their own face coverings, gloves and sanitiser with them to matches and discouraged to shout.

We unfortunately will need to refuse entry to any individual who refuses to provide track and trace details and undertake a temperature check, this is for the safety of all spectators, club officials and players. We hope you understand.
