

TRANSPORT POLICY

- 1. Parents and carers should be made aware that is their responsibility to safely deliver and collect their children to/from matches or training.
- 2. Information regarding planned away fixtures are detailed at the start of the season via the Club website (this includes all fixtures for each of the junior and senior teams).
- 3. Coaches and Club officials will be responsible for children in their care when on the Club premises or on arrival at opponents' cricket grounds.
- 4. It is not the responsibility of the Coach, Team Manager or Club Official to transport, or arrange to transport, the children to and from the Club or match.
- 5. The Club must receive permission from parents/carers for children to participate in competitions and away fixtures. This is arranged through the Junior Membership Form.
- 6. Regarding pick-ups and drop-offs, Club policy is that parents and carers should make clear to coaches and Club officials what arrangements have been made and to keep to those arrangements. Any changes to those arrangements should be communicated to coaches or Club officials as soon as possible, by the most effective means. If children are not collected on time, a call will be made to the parent if they are more than ten minutes late.
- 7. Children playing for senior teams may be given a lift to away fixtures by Club officials. Lifts are only given when there is a Club member with a valid ECB DBS in the car or there is more than one adult in the car the same time.
