Our Purpose & Values




- * Our Club Purpose

Core Values and beliefs will Influence behaviour




- * We are a Charter standard club and proud of that fact.

- Responsibilities include:
- Chair the committee meetings and AGM, assist the Secretary to produce the agendas and head the Committee in making decisions for the benefit of the whole club including disciplinary matters.

Secretary Louise Bickerton

- The main purpose of this role is that of principal administrator for the club
- Responsibilities include:
- Attending league meetings;
- Affiliating the club to the County FA;
- Affiliating the club to the league(s);
- Registering players to the league(s);
- Dealing with correspondence;
- Organising and booking match facilities for the season;

Treasurer Richard Fitzjohr

- The main purpose of this role is to look after the finances of the club.
- Responsibilities include:
- Collecting subscriptions and all money due to the organisation;
- Paying the bills and recording information;
- Keeping up-to -date records of all financial transactions;
- Ensuring that funds are spent properly;
- Reporting regularly to the Committee on the financial position;
- Presenting a year-end financial report to the AGM;
- Financial planning, including producing an annual budget and monitoring it throughout the year;

Child Welfare Officer Nikki Hall

- The main purpose of this role is to be clear about the clubs responsibilities when running activities for children and young people. This involves:
- Ensuring these responsibilities are well understood by others;
- Working with the Youth League Welfare Officer (YLWO);
- Working with your County FA Welfare Officer;
- Promoting The FA's RESPECT Programme and helping to develop best practice processes.
- To help club personnel understand what their duty of care towards children and young people actually means and entails on a day-to-day basis.

Discipline Officer Jason Pile


- To coordinate and administer the requirements of the Regulatory, Sanctioning and Disciplinary processes within the club, in accordance with The FA Rules and Regulations.
