If the **club** has reported it - HRFU will ring and then email the player's school / college with a letter explaining what happened and the process of GRAS. This is normally the medical person in the school, we also cc in the head of sports at the school if we can obtain the email.

In all cases HRFU will: -

- Record the players suspected / confirmed concussion.
- Keep monthly stats on Youth concussions split into M/F.
- Keep a history of HRFU actions per individual case.
- Report to each Game Development Meeting the Concussion statistics
- Monitor for repeat concussions
