About the Role

- As a key holder, coordinate the opening and closure of the clubhouse.
- If not already obtained be able to train for a personal licence certificate or other appropriate qualifications for the role with support from the Club.
- Ensure that the bar, front-of-house, and other areas are clean and maintained.
- Provide appraisals to other members of staff and deal with staff issues
