- ✓ Accessed lottery funding and organised HurstFest, a free community event attended by 2000 people of all ages and social backgrounds, designed to bring together local people to improve community relations, thus reducing antisocial behaviour
- ✓ Organised older peoples Christmas parties.
- ✓ Provided and supported hundreds of hours of volunteering opportunities for people, including teenagers and young adults, that has helped improve employability leading to a number gaining paid employment.
- ✓ Supported local authority efforts to promote credit unions and reduce borrowing from money lenders
- ✓ Joined together with other agencies to develop a child strategy as part of Smallshaw-Hurst Children's Community
- ✓ Supported other local charities and faith groups to further the interest of Hurst residents
