

Expectations for juniors

(to be read by, or read to ALL juniors)

Be organised

- Come to practice or matches on time or inform your Coach/Team Manager as soon as possible if you cannot play or will be late.
- Make sure that the person who is transporting you knows what time to do so and where to go.

Be safe

- A parent/carer or responsible adult should always be at training sessions/matches for your safety.
- Follow the safety rules that your Coach gives you.
- All players under 18 must wear helmets when batting or wicket keeping.

Be smart

- Wear the appropriate cricket kit for matches. Cricket whites and suitable footwear for matches and training kit or sportswear for training. If in doubt contact your Coach/Manager.
- No cricket spikes to be worn in the Off Field Nets.

Show respect

- Listen to your Coach/Team Manager, they are giving their time to help you.
- Be polite to Umpires and respect their decisions.
- Do not throw tantrums or cricket bats!
- Bad language, gestures or inappropriate comments about other players, umpires or officials will not be tolerated at any time.

Enjoy the game

- Play cricket in good spirit and follow the rules of the game.
- Listen to and act upon advice. Everyone is here to learn and continue to improve, even the adults!
- Try to come to watch Senior matches, it helps you improve your game and they enjoy your support.
