Youth rugby is normally safe and injuries are rare. Nevertheless, prevention is better than cure, for our part many of our coaches have Rugby Football Union Qualifications and have also attended first aid courses. A medical problem or disability does not necessarily preclude a child from playing rugby, however your child's coach should be aware of anything to look out for and, if symptoms become apparent, what to do. Also, in the unlikely event of an injury when you are not present, we should be able to authorize emergency treatment.

As a precautionary measure, YOU MUST let us know if your child has suffered an injury during the previous week, particularly a concussion or a head injury, either at home, during any activities or at school

TETANUS	We strongly recommend that all players are up-to-date with anti-tetanus injections.
MOUTH - GUARDS	It is compulsory for players to wear mouth guards during matches and training sessions from the age of U9, and strongly recommended for all other players. Temporary mouth guards are available from the club shop and most sport shops. Please do not hesitate to ask your age group coach for advice on fitting.
FIRST AID	If you have any particular medical or first aid qualifications and would be prepared to help. Please advise the player's relative chairman / Manager (Mini's or Youth) to offer help.
MEDICAL CONSENT	In the event of any illness, accident or injury requiring emergency hospital treatment of the player listed overleaf, I authorize Old Caterhamians Rugby Football Club or any agent acting on their behalf to sign, on my behalf, any written form of consent required by hospital authorities, if a delay to obtain my signature is considered inadvisable by the doctor or surgeon concerned.
