## **Code of Conduct for Spectators**

## For those attending training sessions or home or away fixtures involving Bangor Rugby Football Club Age-Grade Players

- Remember that Age-Grade Players are not 'miniature internationals'.
- Be on your best behaviour and lead by example. Do not use bad language or harass referees, players or coaches.
- Applaud good play by the visiting team as well as your own.
- Show respect for your team's opponents.
- Condemn the use of violence in all forms at every opportunity.
- Verbal abuse of referees, Age-Grade Players, or Sports Leaders is unacceptable.
- Age-Grade Players or Sports Leaders are not fair targets for ignorant behaviour.
- Encourage Age-Grade Players to play by the Laws of the Game.
- Spectators can contribute to the enjoyment of the event and all involved.
- Be proud of your association with Bangor Rugby Football Club and the Game of Rugby.
- Always respect Club facilities and property. Take care of equipment and furnishings owned by the Club and use the waste-bins provided around the grounds and in the Clubhouse for the disposal of any litter.
