Re: The Hosting Of GCA Matches By Clubs.

In an effort to streamline our competitions and speed up their completion, the Georgetown Cricket Association (GCA) took the following decisions resulting from discussions among club captains, club coaches and the Competitions Committee (CC):

1. The GCA fixtures will indicate the designated host for each First and Second Division match. These fixtures will be distributed to each club at least fourteen days prior to the start of each competition.
2. A club that is the designated host for a match being played at a venue other than their own shall pay a fee of seven thousand dollars (\$7,000) for a two day match and four thousand dollars (\$4,000) for a one day match. The fee is designed to assist clubs with the expense related to having a neutral match played at their venue.
3. The Chairman of the Competitions Committee will collect the fees and issue a receipt. The Chairman of the CC will pay those fees over to the club where the match was played and will in turn require a receipt.
4. Having been issued with fixtures in advance of each competition, clubs are required to inform the Chairman of the CC, within ten days of receipt of the fixtures, of the dates on which their venue would be unavailable for matches to be played.
5. A club having initially accepted to host a match at their venue must give the Chairman of the CC at least seventy-two (72) hours notice if it can no longer have the match played at its venue. That club would however, remain the host of that game when a venue is found for that match.
6. If less than seventy-two (72) hours notice is given then it is the responsibility of the offending host club to find a replacement venue for that match or risk forfeiting the match with full points being awarded to the opposing team.
