KINGSTONIAN CLUB HISTORY

Kingstonian Football Club is an English semi-professional football club based in the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames, southwest London which currently plays in the Isthmian League Premier Division.

The club was founded in 1885 by YMCA, named Kingston & Surbiton YMCA, and began competing properly in 1893 in the Surrey Junior Cup. There was a split before the start of the 1908–1909 season which damaged the club, the two clubs were named Old Kingstonians and Kingston upon Thames A.F.C. After period of quiet during World War I, the two clubs re-united and joined the Athenian League in 1919, named Kingstonian.

In 1929, their application to join the Isthmian League was accepted, and they have competed there to the present day. The club, nicknamed "The K's" or "The Ks", spent three seasons at the highest level of non-league football, 1998–99, 1999–2000 and 2000–01, and have won the FA Trophy twice, in consecutive seasons, in 1999 and 2000.

The club is currently without a home ground, and groundshares with Tooting & Mitcham United at Imperial Fields in Morden. They have twice previously had their own stadium, Richmond Road from 1902–1988 and Kingsmeadow from 1989–2017. After Kingstonian went into administration in 2001, Kingsmeadow was bought by AFC Wimbledon two years later, who allowed Kingstonian to stay. With AFC Wimbledon looking to move to a new ground, Kingsmeadow was sold to Chelsea F.C. in 2016, who stipulated that Kingstonian could not remain there.

In 1919 football was rejuvenated in Kingston. The war had dimmed the rivalry between the teams, and they re-united as Kingstonian F.C. Their first match after unification was on 6 September 1919 competing in the Athenian League against Southall F.C. However, the season was plagued with issues regarding their home ground at Richmond Road and a finish in the bottom half of the league meant the team were forced to apply to re-enter the league. Their application was successful, and heralded a change of fortunes for Kingstonian.

Before the 1920–1921 season it seemed they had lost their ground after confusion over their desire to renew the rent. This meant that Leyland Motors had been given exclusive use but an agreement was reached to allow for a groundshare with Leyland Motors and Leyland Motors took over the fixtures of the Kingstonian Reserve team who had signed up for the Southern Suburban League. The following season Kingstonian were successful in purchasing the Richmond Road ground, although the groundshare arrangement with Leyland Motors continued. They had a more successful spell from 1923 up to the outbreak of World War II, winning the league in 1924, and in 1926 with a record number of points. The club progressed to several finals of the London and Surrey Senior Cups.

In 1929, Kingstonian were successful in their application to join the Isthmian League after the withdrawal of Civil Service F.C. In 1933, Kingstonian won the FA Amateur Cup, they won the League in 1934 and 1937, and the club won the Surrey Senior Cup in 1935 and 1939. "Competitive Amateur Football" was called off in September 1939 for World War II and Kingstonian were to play only one game at the start of the 1939/1940 season. Their ground was requisitioned by the Civil Defence for the duration of the war and no further games were played until 1945. Depleted of the majority of their pre-war players, Kingstonian came last in the first league after the war in 1945–1946 season, and had to resort to fundraising to gather money to renovate both the stadium and the changing rooms.

In 1949, the all-time top goalscorer Johnny Whing arrived at the club, and was top scorer in nine different seasons for the club.[3] In 1955, Kingstonian's heaviest ever home defeat, 12–3, was recorded at the hands of Bishop Auckland FC in front of the club's record attendance of 8,960.

KINGSTONIAN CLUB HISTORY

In the 1959–60 season, the K's had their first Wembley Stadium appearance in the FA Amateur Cup final, which was lost to Hendon F.C. 2–1. In 1963, Kingstonian won the double; the Surrey and London Senior Cup.

The 1970s were a period of decline for the club, and despite becoming professional in 1975, they were relegated to Division One in 1979. In 1985 Kingstonian were once again promoted to the Isthmian League, finishing second.

In 1987, 20 years without silverware was ended by the K's winning the London Senior Cup.

Kingstonian won the Isthmian League in 1998 and the FA Trophy in 1999 and 2000 at Wembley Stadium under manager Geoff Chapple, and then managed to reach the fourth round of the FA Cup in 2001.

Entering the competition at the Fourth Qualifying Round, they beat Devizes Town before beating two Football League clubs – Brentford and Southend United, either side of a win over fellow Conference team Southport – on their way to the FA Cup fourth round, where they were drawn with Bristol City before succumbing to a late winner in the replay, losing 1–0.

Changes during mid-2006 with Mark Anderson and Malcolm Winwright taking charge of the club, installing Stuart McIntyre as successor to Ian McDonald in the role of head coach. However, McIntyre's stay in the role was brief and "unsuccessful", with he himself being replaced by Alan Dowson at the start of 2007.

Under Dowson the club was promoted back to the Isthmian Premier in 2009. However, after the 2013–14 Isthmian League in which Kingstonian finished second but missed out on promotion, on 11 May 2014 Dowson resigned, being replaced by Tommy Williams.

With former K's midfielder Tommy Williams installed as manager, the club again reached the FA Cup Third Qualifying Round, losing 3–2 to a last minute goal against Eastbourne Borough. The league campaign saw the club make late challenge for the play-offs falling short in the last couple of weeks of the season. In his second season, the 2015–16 campaign saw the K's lift their first cup in ten years, winning the Isthmian League Cup with a 5–0 victory over Faversham Town.

The 2016–17 season started poorly with the club just outside the relegation zone with six games remaining. Tommy Williams was replaced as manager by former Billericay Town man Craig Edwards. He led the club to a 16th place finish after a five match unbeaten run to end the season. K's left the Kingsmeadow Stadium at the end of the season and moved to Fetcham Grove to groundshare with Leatherhead.

Edwards resigned in October 2017 and was replaced by former Whyteleafe manager Leigh Dynan.

At the beginning of the 2018–19 season, Kingstonian moved back to the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames and started a ground share with Corinthian-Casuals at King George's Field. A difficult season saw K's have three managers, as Leigh Dynan was replaced by Dean Brennan and then very quickly by stand-in manager Kim Harris – K's moved from second place in the table on New Year's Day to escaping relegation by a single place.

New manager Hayden Bird joined the club in 2019, only for the 2019–20 season to be curtailed by the COVID-19 pandemic. In that season's FA Cup the K's reached the First Round for the first time since 2000–01, where they defeated Macclesfield Town 4–0 at Moss Rose, before losing 2–0 at home to AFC Fylde in the Second Round.





PLAYER PROFILES



Michael Abnett (Defender): Signed for Kingstonian in September 2022, Michael is best known for his spell with Merstham, with whom he reached the FA Cup First Round and the Isthmian League Premier play-off final.

Kenny Beaney (Midfield): Very experienced central midfielder who joined the K's from Merstham in the summer of 2019 and is also club captain. Previous clubs include Dulwich Hamlet, where he was captain of their promotion winning team in 2018, Wealdstone, Beckenham Town, Grays Athletic and Thurrock.

Nodirbek Bobomurodov (Midfield): Signed on a dual registration basis from Worthing in October 2022, Uzbekistan-born Nodirbek is a speedy winger who has previously played for Cheshunt, Corinthian-Casuals and Hungerford Town before joining Worthing in July 2022.

Sean Bonnett-Johnson (Midfield): Originally joined Kingstonian in December 2015 and was part of the K's League Cup Final victory over Faversham Town in 2016. A widely travelled player who has also played for the likes of Billericay Town, Merstham, Braintree Town and Dundee, Sean played the 2021-22 season with FC Romania and re-joined the K's in the summer of 2022.

Kieron Cadogan (Midfield / Forward): A former Crystal Palace player who signed for Kingstonian in the summer of 2022. Kieron played 21 times for the Eagles and had loan spells with Burton Albion and Rotherham United before playing for Aldershot Town, Barnet, and GAIS Goteborg before three seasons in the National League with Sutton United.

Mac Chisholm (Goalkeeper): Joined the K's in the summer of 2022, Mac started out in the youth system at Fulham before moving to Watford and in the 2021-22 season was in the U23s squad for West Bromwich Albion.

Louis Collins (Defence / Midfield): Son of popular former K's man Liam Collins, Louis came through the academy system at Walton and Hersham, eventually playing for the first team and winning promotion back to the Isthmian League in 2021-22. During the summer of 2022, Louis made the short move to Kingstonian.

Thomas Gogo (Midfield / Forward): A former West Ham United youth player, Thomas joined the K's in the summer of 2022 having spent several years at Potters Bar Town. Having left West Ham, Thomas had spells with Staines Town and Beaconsfield before moving to the Scholars in 2018.

Sam Jackson (Goalkeeper): Joined Kingstonian in September 2022 after leaving Welling United, Sam began his career in the youth sections at Dartford, Gillingham and Millwall, before moving north of Hadrian's Wall to join Dundee in 2018. He then signed a one-year deal with Aberdeen before joining Braintree Town in 2020 and then Welling United in January 2022.

Isaiah Jones (Defence): A former Southampton junior who joined Forest Green Rovers in 2018. He made two appearances for the club in the EFL Trophy before a loan spell with Cirencester Town before spending most of last season with Chesham United.

Lee Lewis (Midfield): Joined Kingstonian from Chertsey Town in October 2022, Lee progressed through the youth and reserve teams of Cray Wanderers before breaking into the first team squad. Lee then joined the Curfews in the summer of 2022.

Tobi Ogundega (Defence): Joined K's on loan from Sutton United in August 2022, having joined the U's the previous month. Before joining Sutton, he was an Under 18s player for MK Dons.



PLAYER PROFILES



David Lopes (Forward): A graduate of Kingstonian's under 18s team, David signed first team forms in the winter of the 2021-22 season. Scored 21 goals for the Under 18s in 2021-22, including two each in player-of-the-match performances in the Combined Counties Youth League Cup and Grant McLellan Cup Finals. Currently playing for Egham Town on a dual registration basis.

Geneiro Maragh (Defence): A former West Ham United youngster that signed for Kingstonian in the summer of 2022, Geneiro is a full back who has spent time in the academy system with Cambridge United.

Iker Noguera Leon (Midfield): Joined Kingstonian's Under 18s set-up in the summer of 2021, Iker signed first team forms in the winter of that season and made his first team debut at Sheerwater in a Surrey Senior Cup tie in January 2022. He was part of the Under 18s' double cup winning squad at the end of the 2021-22 season.

Kwesi Ntim (Midfield): Another graduate of Kingstonian's Under 18s team, Kwesi signed first team forms in January 2022 and made his first team debut in the same month and was part in the centre of midfield of the youth team's double cup winning squad.

Tyrese Owen (Defence / Midfield): Signed for Kingstonian in the summer of 2022 after having spent the previous season with Haringey Borough. He joined the Borough from Hemel Hempstead Town, and also counts Potters Bar Town and Carshalton Athletic as former clubs, also spending time with Ytterhogdals IK in the Swedish fourth tier.

Corey Parchment (Defence): Signed for Kingstonian in September 2022 from Potters Bar Town, it is the second time that K's manager Lee O'Leary has signed the full-back who also counts Windsor, Westfield, Hillingdon Borough and Bedworth United as former clubs.

Dwight Pascal (Defence): Made his first team debut for Barnet at the age of fifteen and is the Bees' youngest ever player. He played on two more occasions for Barnet before joining Potters Bar Town in November 2019. He returned to the Hive in 2020 but re-joined the Scholars in time for the 2021-22 season, subsequently moving to Kingstonian in the summer of 2022.

Declan Skura (Defence): A player with experience at academy level with Chelsea and Reading, Declan was part of Hanworth Villa's exceptional FA Youth Cup run in 2019-20 that saw them reach the Second Round Proper.

Rob Tolfrey (Goalkeeper): Kingstonian's record-appearance maker, Rob broke Micky Preston's record of 557 appearances in September 2021 and is fast approaching the 600 mark. He started his career with Crawley Town before spending one season with Whyteleafe and then secured a move to Horsham. In 2009, Rob moved to Kingstonian and has been the undisputed number one ever since.

Ben Ward-Cochrane (Forward): Signed for Kingstonian in September 2022 from Walthamstow, and has previously played under Lee O'Leary with Potters Bar Town, and also Enfield Town, Hertford Town and a dual registration spell with Welling United when Potters Bar were unable to play due to the Isthmian League season being cancelled in 2020-21.

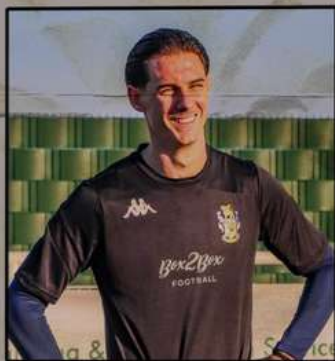
