

The Aberdeen Sporting Hall of Fame, created during our 21st Anniversary in 2006, was launched at the Aberdeen Sports Village, as one of the Highlights of the Aberdeen Sports Council's 30th Anniversary Celebrations, on September 4th, 2015. The first Intake was for Aberdeen born Sportsmen and Sportswomen who had reached the highest Levels in their chosen Sports. The second Tranche was for the European Cup Winners Cup Team, the Gothenburg Dons and the third Tranche consisted of Sportsmen and Sportswomen who had served the City of Aberdeen through their Sports....but were not, Aberdeen Born. Already, we have Nominations for the fourth Tranche, which shall be announced at the end of 2016... and further Nominations are being sought....and should be submitted to – info@aberdeensportscouncil.com – with the Athlete's Name, Sport and potted History of their achievements and your reasons for the Nomination. These persons should have achieved the highest levels of Sporting Excellence, in their chosen Sports.

The Aberdeen Sporting Hall of Fame Honour Board (Kindly sponsored by Lofthus Signs) which shall hopefully encourage future generations of Local Athletes to endeavour to follow in the steps of many Local Sports Stars, may be seen in the Entrance to the Aberdeen Sports Village, at the left of the Reception Desk. Rio Olympic and Paralympic Games

The Games of the XXXI Olympiad, shall be held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, from 5th to 21st August 2016 and more than 10,500 athletes from 206 National Olympic Committees, will take part. The Games will feature 28 Sports — including Rugby 7's and Golf, which were added by the International Olympic Committee in 2009. These Sporting events will take place across 33 venues spread across four regions of the city namely – Barra, Copacabana, Deodoro, and Maracanã. The 15th Summer Paralympic Games will be held from the 7th to 18th September 2016 and 22 Sports are scheduled to be contested. The two new Sports added to the Paralympics in Rio, are Canoeing and the Triathlon.

Synchronized Ice Skating

At the ISU World Synchronized Skating Championships in Budapest, Hungary; Great Britain was represented by Aberdeen based Team Zariba ranking 23rd in the World. The competition ran over Friday 8th April and Saturday 9th April, when the Syma Hall played host to the greatest Synchronized Skating talent from around the World. The current British Champions - Team Zariba - with Skaters ranging from 16 to 25 years old, was selected to represent Great Britain at the world class event during one of their best seasons on record. They were crowned Senior British Champions at the British Synchronized Skating Championships held in January, and retained their Scottish title for the fourth year in a row at the Trophy d' Eccose.

CONGRATULATIONS to -

1 Aberdeen Sporting Hall of Fame Inductee – Elaine Farquharson Black - Captain of the recent Curtis Cup Winning Team... Great Britain and Ireland survived a fierce American fightback to claim a dramatic victory in the 39th Curtis Cup at Dun Laoghaire Golf Club, south of Dublin. The home side started the singles with an 8-4 lead over the visitors but they had to fight all the way to secure an 11 V_2 - 8 V_2 victory after the battling Americans edged the singles by 4 V_2 - 3 V_2 . The victory marked just the eighth time GB & I has emerged victorious in a contest which was inaugurated all the way back in 1932 but it does mean they have now won twice in-a-row on home soil after their previous victory at Nairn in northern Scotland four years ago. Aberdeen Sports Council, was delighted to receive this EXCLUSIVE Message from Elaine –

It was a tremendous honour to captain the Curtis Cup team in Dun Laoghaire, 24 years after I played in the winning team in Hoylake. It was also a privilege to be the first Scot to captain the team since Belle Robertson 40 years ago. With an elite team, I saw my role as captain to be less about motivation and more about inspiration and providing the environment to enable the team to play to their full potential. This covered practical aspects, such as making sure we had their favourite snacks and (loud) music in the team room, as well as reminding the players about the history of the Curtis Cup match and their role in upholding the tradition of stimulating friendly rivalry among women golfers of many lands and making the 2016 match one which people will remember and talk about in years to come. The team played fantastic golf, with 27 birdies from the matches on the first day, 28 birdies and 1 eagle on the second day and 20 birdies on the final day. Saturday was a particular highlight: we won the morning foursomes 2-1 and then won the fourballs 3-0 to take a 4 point lead into the singles.

All in all, a wonderful week.
