Information for cricket participants at Thrumpton Cricket Club – Covid 19

Thrumpton Cricket Club are happy to provide our ground for cricket use subject to compliance with the guidance issued by the English Cricket Board in respect of all recreational cricket from 11 July 2020. The Thrumpton committee have carried out the necessary risk assessment and have taken action to ensure that the ground complies with that guidance. The full risk assessment is available to view on the clubs website. This document provides a simplified guide as to how cricket activities at Thrumpton Cricket Club should be undertaken, from arrival at the ground through to leaving after the match. Please share the contents of this letter and the attached guidance with your team before your game at Thrumpton Cricket Club.

You should remember that although the club has taken reasonable measures to minimise the risk of Covid transmission whilst participating in cricket at Thrumpton Cricket Club, there is an increase in transmission risk associated with partaking in even socially distanced group activity and all participants must be clear that they are opting to participate in cricket activity.

Ensuring that the guidance is followed is a matter for individual team captains and age-group managers in respect of their own players (and any spectators). If you find yourself playing a game where the opposition are not meeting these requirements then initially please try highlighting the issue and help to put it right. Please note that Thrumpton Cricket Club can and will abandon any games if persistent abuse of the guidance occurs, although I do not anticipate that this will be required.

Thrumpton CC: Covid Cricket Guidance 2020

In line with current Government guidance, if you are symptomatic, living in a household with a possible COVID-19 infection or if you are classified as extremely vulnerable on health grounds, you should remain at home and follow Government guidance.

The following guidance is applicable to games at **Thrumpton CC:**

Pre - game

No changing rooms will be available. You should therefore arrive in appropriate kit or get changed in your car before the game.

Seating areas will be set out for both teams on arrival. Players should maintain appropriate social distancing in the seating areas.

Toilets

Toilets are open in the pavilion but please follow the one way system in place. Hand washing facilities with anti-bac soap and paper towels will be provided.

No-one should enter the clubhouse or toilets without firstly sanitising their hands.

Test & Trace

To comply with test and trace requirements, a list of all participants (players, scorers, umpires, coaches, spectators etc.) and their contact details should be submitted by each team captain or age-group manager to a Thrumpton CC representative before the start of the game. There will also be a signing in table on entry to the ground for any additional club members or visitors.

This information will be kept for 21 days and then destroyed. Thrumpton Cricket Club will not, in any circumstances, share any personal information and this data is only being collected for the purposes of Covid-19 contact tracing.

Match guidance

In line with ECB guidance, please take note of the following:

- Players should bring their own drinks and hand sanitizer
- No sweat or saliva should be applied to the ball at any time
- A hygiene break should take place every 6 overs (or 20 minutes), when the ball is cleaned with anti-bacterial product and players hands are cleaned using sancitiser

- Batsmen should run outside of the line markings at the side of the wicket whenever possible, to minimise close contact
- Bowlers should not hand items to the umpire. Leave them on the boundary
- Avoid sharing equipment with other players
- Minimise sharing of the ball by returning it directly from wicketkeeper to bowler
- 2m distancing should be maintained wherever possible - only the wicket-keeper and slips may be closer
- There should be no direct hand to hand contact
- Sanitizer will be available by the side of the pitch

Between innings

Appropriate social distancing should be maintained and all players should take the opportunity to clean their hands with a sanitiser. No hospitality or teas will be provided. Participants should bring their own food and drinks. Drinking water will be available.

Post-match

After the game, please leave all equipment (stumps chairs etc.) in place and return kit to your car. If the clubs Bar Facilities are open please follow the one way system in place and maintain social distancing. **Please note only one person is permitted to be at the bar at any one time.**
