Umpires needed!

Without them there is no game.

How many of you turn up and think to yourself "blimey so and so is umpiring us again".

As Kettering HC expands we need more whistle blowers. Remember not that long ago we only had 6 teams and the Mens and Ladies first teams had appointed umpires so we have gone from having to provide 4 umpires a week to at least 8.

The problem we have is that with the notable exceptions of Chris and Bert everyone else still plays so our umpiring appointments are at the mercy of the match times and locations etc. It's tricky to umpire the 1130 game at Kettering when you are playing in Ely at 3!! We have a small band of ex panel umpires we use but their availability is not 'every week' so we have to back fill using the club members.

The Club will subsidise an Umpiring Course and we pay £15 for every match you umpire. Keep an eye on the Club Website for the next Umpiring Course.

In October Shez, Lewis, Dom, Matt all took the course and Shez has since passed the assessment. Woody and Meg also completed the course last season and are looking to be assessed. If you have an umpiring qualification and we don't know about it let Claire Jones or Tom know. Even if you just do one game it takes a bit of pressure off everyone else.

If you think that it will be a nightmare and everyone will shout at you this is not the case and the players are really grateful that someone is willing to umpire. You don't have to be a player either. If you are a parent and want to get involved let us know.


