- 5.1 We introduced e-payments for the Men's pre-pre-season training and the interclub friendly (14th July) with some success.

 Membership and annual subs have been added to the website with the following take up (at 28/8):

- 5.3 According to Pitchero since we started e-payments our revenue has been £1,817, this does include some cash taken at the inter-club friendly but excludes cash from pre-pre-season training, fitness and summer camp.
