1. Please ensure all players have a gum shield for every training and match session. Failure to use a gum shield may result in a player being refused the opportunity to play due to safety considerations.
2. Club jerseys, shorts and socks to be worn for all match fixtures. All items of club wear are available from the club shop located in the clubhouse.
3. Eligibility for a team is governed by a player's date of birth. The date of eligibility is **1st January**

4. Rugby is a contact sport and although rare, accidents can occur. All parents / guardians should be aware that Muskerry RFC's insurance policy is very limited in the extent of cover available in the event of an accident and extends to serious injury only (death, disablement or loss of limb). Medical costs associated with treatment for injuries incurred whilst playing rugby cannot be covered by the club.
Muskerry RFC would advise that parents / players make their own arrangements to have some form of personal accident insurance in place to cover medical expenses that may be incurred as a result of sporting injury.
