Welcome to today's game and once again, thank you for your efforts and support over the past 12 months.

Last year was a busy year particularly on the land project and the pace and pressure will increase even more this year. I would like to take this opportunity to update you on where we stand with the fund raising.

Can I remind you that we need to raise £200,000 ourselves over the next 2 years towards the cost of phase 1 of the project in order to access grants for the remainder of the costs to level, drain and sow the pitches. The lead time for the pitches to mature means that we would like to start the first phase as soon as we can **so we need your help now.**

We are in the process of applying for Charitable status for O&WCSC, the application has been submitted to the charity commission so will hopefully be in place in the next 3 months which should allow donations to qualify for gift aid.

I quoted some numbers at the FOPs dinner in November and have since had more donations passed over from WPCC and from our membership secretary. We have a total of 99 individual donors this includes those members who have added a small donation onto their membership payment. All donors (names only) will be published in our next newsletter and will be carried forward into a more permanent recognition once we occupy our new ground. We are open to suggestions on what type of recognition you think would be appropriate.

In the 4 months since we sent appeal letters to all members and former members we have received donations and pledges totalling £56,000, if we add to that the potential gift aid associated with the pledges that takes the amount up to between £67,000 and £70,000. When we then add in the proceeds from the Dinner Dance that takes the total to nearly £75,000. The club also has a separate fund built up over recent years largely from the proceeds of the 200 club and some one-off donations which could add to that. We still need about a further £110,000 to hit our target for the first phase of the project. However, if we take into account possible associated gift aid, our target comes down £90,000. So we are around half way to our total. But we cannot get complacent or rely on a relatively few generous members we need all members to help in whatever way thev can.

Please don't think that you can't contribute because you can't make a lump sum (or a promise of a lump sum) payment. We've had a couple of members set up a monthly Standing Order to the club (in addition to their membership) and are making a monthly donation to the JV Fund and are happy to extend this to any of our members and supporters who would like to contribute in this way. Please get in touch with either myself or the Treasurer Karl Lee, who will provide you with details of how to do this

At last count we had some 270 adult members so there are many more that haven't donated than those that have so let's see if we can double the number of 99 donors by this summer.

Visitors to Orrell were Winnington Park, who Orrell had lost to Away in October 28 – 0. Winnington Park had not lost a game all season and were keen to keep their unbeaten record.

Matthew Johnson on the Left Wing and Andrew Bourne on the Right Wing were both playing their first game for the Senior Side.

Almost immediately from the start of the game, the visitors give away a penalty. Orrell kick for touch and get a line-out midway in Winnington's half. Orrell win the line out, and the visitors again give away a penalty. After 10 minutes with all the play in the visitor's half and after they had given away several more penalties, Chis Owen kicks a penalty to give Orrell the lead 3 – 0.

From the restart Orrell give away a penalty and Winnington kick for touch and they win the line out and kick over Orrell's defensive line, only for the ball to go dead. Play however continues in the Orrell half. Winnington's pack put pressure on Orrell's lighter pack, and occasionally, at an Orrell put in they take the ball against the head. The visitors continue to attack the Orrell line and from a Winnington Line out 10 metres from the try line, they catch the ball and drive over, only for the ball to be held up over the line, by Orrell's defence. Later in the game Winnington had a 5-metre scrum, out from the Orrell try line, but after winning the ball, they knock on and Orrell cleared their line.

In the last few minutes of the half, Orrell managed to get the ball into their opponents' half, and good hands, quickly move the ball out to winger Mat Johnson and from 20 metres out he beat an attempt tackle and touched down in the corner for a try. This was his First try for Orrell's 1st team in his first game for the 1st team. Chris Owen converted the try and the referee whistled for half time with the score Orrell 10 Winnington Park 0.

Immediately from the restart Orrell give away a penalty. The visitors kick for touch and get a line out 10 metres from the try line. They win the throw in and drive the ball over the line, but the ball is again held up. However, a few minutes later from a scrum 5 metres out, Winnington again pick up and drive, to score their first try of the game. The try was converted to make the score Orrell 10 Winnington Park 7.

Midway through the half, from a line out Winnington Park again pick up and drive, but again Orrell defence held the ball up over the try line. However, with less than 10 minutes left in the game, Orrell give away a penalty, in their own half. Winnington tapped the ball and drove over the try line to score their 2nd try, which was unconverted, but gave the visitors the lead for the first time in the game. Orrell 10 Winnington Park 12.

In the dying minutes of the game, the visitor wins a line out on half way and move the ball down field and get another line out 15 metres out. They win the ball again and drive over the line to touch down for their 3rs try, which was converted to make the final score Orrell 10 Winnington Park 19.


