Orrell RUFC vs Ellesmere Port

ORRELL ON FIRE AT ELLESMERE PORT

After the trauma of a players car on fire on the motorway and some players going the wrong facility Orrell eventually took to the field with 15 men. Thanks to Ellesmere Port and Referee for delaying the kick-off. Game on.

Port kick off and take the ball to Orrell in the forwards and the early exchanges see Orrell give away 6 penalties. Orrell handled the resultant pressure from Port well and settle down to some open exciting rugby.

On 12' from a solid Orrell scrum the backs pass the ball through the hands to Matty Stott on the wing and finishes off nicely in the corner. Conversion missed first blood to Orrell 0-5.

With Port on the back foot and Orrell's confidence growing on 17' a superb break from Kyle Herbert and exchange to Josh Grant Orrell scores under the posts. Conversion kicked by James Ratcliffe and lead is extended to 0-12.

With Orrell now in full control, and silky handling from backs Tom Halsall crosses the line again in the corner on 37', conversion missed HT score Port 0-17

Second half under way and the introduction of late arrival Jack Granby saw Port go further behind, good handling and power by Jack Granby he crosses the try line and conversion by James Ratcliffe 0-24, 46' on the clock.

Port re-gather from the kick off and slack play from Orrell allow Port to score under the visitors post on 54' conversion kicked 7-24.

Jack Booth comes on for his first team debut and replaces Max Huxley. Twinkle toes running from Scrum Half Adam Worley scores in the corner 7-29. Straight from the kick off Orrell break through the Ports defence again and the electric pace from Jack Granby scores his 2nd try of the match 7-34.

The final try of the match comes from a sparkling run by Matty Johnson and with conversion by James Ratcliffe final score Ellesmere Port 7-41.

Andrew Craig (born 16 March 1976) St Helens

We are delighted to introduce and welcome Andy Craig as today's former player host for the 1xv team game vs Garstang. After a successful RL career with Wigan and Scotland, Andy decided to switch codes and joined Orrell in 2000. Andy made 80 appearances for Orrell scoring 295 points in 4 years including winning the Powergen Shield in 2003 beating Exeter Chiefs 26-20 at Twickenham.

Whilst playing at Orrell, Craig earned his first cap for Scotland on Saturday, 15 June 2002 against Canada in Vancouver, in 26-23 defeat. Later that year, Craig joined the elite to became one of only 15 Scotland players to have scored a hat-trick after his three tries against Fiji. Craig played 23 international test matches scoring 8 tries



Welcome to our first game of the season for our first team. You will notice a lot of changes around the college as we expand our use of these excellent facilities. We will continue to increase how we use the sports and catering facilities over the first half of the season and beyond. I hope we can create a more club-like atmosphere at the ground and that you enjoy the match day experience, let us know what you think.

This is a first step in creating a place where members, players and guests can socialise before and after the match and it is worth reminding ourselves of the spirit and values that developed in the past from the social aspects of the game and helped foster the broad team and club spirit that brought the club such great success in past years, may it do so again.

The next much bigger step will be to start work our own facilities and bring even more stability and opportunities to develop the club spirit. As we continue our fundraising effort make no mistake the project to build our own facilities is vitally important to the long term development of the club.

The first move towards our goal will be on the **19th of October** this year when we get access to the land on Winstanley Road to start our development. Our immediate plans are:

- 1. Complete the work necessary to discharge the planning conditions which will ensure we do not need to reapply for planning permission which wil include; erect fencing, build an entrance, complete the detailed drainage designs, produce phased implementation plans. Nov 19 to June 20
- 2. Initiate the application for grants to help fund the development of the land. **Now to May 20**
- 3. Continue to press hard on the fund raising activities to raise sufficient funds to support the grant applications, the grant agencies expect to see a material amount of "matching funds" coming from any applicants.
- 4. To complete the collection of pledged donations and appeal again to the many members who have yet to contribute. Appeal letters will be in the post to member in the next week. However there is no need to wait to be asked speak to me directly and I can give you the forms.

In terms of fund raising we expect our development fund to have reached £60,000 by October when all pledges are collected which will rise to £75,000 when associated gift aid is received. This is enough to fund the activities outlined in point 1 above. By the end of the year we have a target of

raising that to £100,000 as a result of additional donations and fund raising events which will be pursuing over October and November.

This is a tremendous effort and thanks go to all donors and club volunteers for their help and support in achieving it. We estimate that we will need to raise a further £50,000 next year to provide sufficient match funds for our grant applications. So we need help from all members NOW to either commit to making a donation, introduce potential donors or sponsors or simply volunteer to help on match days and at fund raising events.

Please don't think that you can't contribute because you can't make a lump sum (or a promise of a lump sum) payment. We've had a couple of members set up a monthly Standing Order to the club (in addition to their membership) and are making a monthly donation to the JV Fund and we are happy to extend this to any of our members and supporters who would like to contribute in this way. Please get in touch with either myself or the Treasurer Karl Lee, who will provide you with details of how to do this.

Last year we had some 270 adult members this year we expect that number to grow. There are many more members that haven't donated than those that have so let's see if we can add 50 new donors by the end of the year.

I hope that you enjoy the game and are able to stay for postmatch refreshments. If you have any questions, suggestions, concerns, or would like to volunteer some help I will be happy to discuss with you over a drink
