### **CURRENT COVID-19 PICTURE**

Welcome to your first Covid-19 update of the new 2020/21 season!

As your Covid Officer, I have been working closely with the committee, coaches and volunteers to get netball activity up and running in these most unprecedented of times. Some incredibly hard work has been taking place by lots of people and I'd like to outline where we are up to, and why.

### The first steps

On 9 July, England Netball announced netball activity could return in England in a phased manner, starting with 'stage 2' of their roadmap. At this point, we mobilised our Prem, East Region and academy u16 squads to carry out weekly fitness based activity in the advised way, and our u15, 14, 13 and 12's on a bi-weekly basis.

#### It's all about the science

In order to move beyond this stage, England Netball were required to carry out analysis on the 'idle interaction' time for court based activity before the government could confirm a further return to the sport. Upon analysis, England Netball identified that, as an example, the GS and GK regularly spend close to 49 minutes within the 2m social distanced proximity during an average match and the challenge was to find a way to reduce this to under 15 minutes. This has been achieved by encouraging players to ensure they are at an adequate 2m social distance when the ball is either out of play, or adequately far down court and in the possession of the opposition. Upon achieving confirmation from the government that these rule modifications were adequate, England Netball announced netball activity could move from stage 2 to stage 4a. With this announcement we mobilised further to return to slightly more activity and within a week, had all academy squads (including new u11's) on a new pre academy 4 week training programme and our Prem and East Region training groups permitted greater numbers; both sections using all 4 outdoor courts at Hellesdon High School. Our first JDC activity pilot started up at Attleborough too.

### Why we can't just press go!

We have attempted to stagger the returns to activity in order to assess the viability and whether our processes are working which is why your activity may not currently be taking place. But we are working closely with our relevant coaches and managers to get you going as soon as is safely possible.

### The changes that will affect you

It's safe to say that in an ever changing landscape we are working very hard to react to relevant measures and ensure the safety, health and wellbeing of all our members and their families

In order to achieve this, we have a number of processes in place which everyone must carry out.

#### Pre-session

Please ensure you complete the Norfolk United track and trace and health form (via our QR code) up to 24 hours ahead of your session. Any parents spectating in a permitted area must also fill the form in.

### Reporting protocol

Pre-session

If an NUNC member develops Covid-19 symptoms (a new and continuous cough, temperature or a loss/change in sense of smell or taste) PRIOR to attending a Norfolk United session, you **MUST NOT** attend. Please ensure to inform NHS Test and Trace, obtain a test, inform your coach and the Norfolk United Covid Officer — nunccovidofficer@gmail.com

Post-session

If an NUNC member develops Covid-19 symptoms within 48 hours of attending a session run by Norfolk United, you must inform NHS Test and Trace, obtain a test, inform your coach and the Norfolk United Covid Officer — <a href="mailto:nunccovidofficer@gmail.com">nunccovidofficer@gmail.com</a>

You **WILL NOT** be allowed to attend any sessions until either 10 days have elapsed, or you can provide evidence of a negative test.

### A positive test

If you are able to receive a test and get a positive result please inform Norfolk United Covid Officer — <a href="mailto:nunccovidofficer@gmail.com">nunccovidofficer@gmail.com</a> who will then work with your regular sessional coach to inform any of your team mates who may wish to isolate or receive a test. Please be aware that if you have a test within 48 hours attending a session that comes back positive, you obliged to inform NHS Test and Trace and the Norfolk United Covid Officer - <a href="mailto:nunccovidofficer@gmail.com">nunccovidofficer@gmail.com</a> immediately, regardless of symptoms.
