### **CURRENT COVID-19 PICTURE**

Wow! What a week it's been.

### What's been happening

Since my last newsletter the Government have thrown us some curve balls and we have been challenged with activating more club activity.

On Tuesday 22 September it was decided that the 'Rule of 6' would include all adult indoor sporting activity, followed up by a statement from Sport England that this would come in to effect on 24 September. We were holding out for some further guidance directly from England Netball later that week but it never came.

Our leadership team then activated a plan of action for the Prem and ER teams as trials loomed heavy over the players just a few days later. It was decided to postpone the trials on the Sunday morning (partially impacted by weather, partially impacted by the change of facility requirement) and an activity plan to continue supporting the hard work all the girls had put in already, was created.

Since this date, our Prem and ER teams have continued strength and conditioning training on a Monday night at Hellesdon High School, the dwindling light resulting in reduced ball skill activity, and taken up outside training slots at Sportspark on Wednesday evenings until a more formal plan can be actioned.

In addition to this, our pre academy groups have moved through fitness to ball skills to activating match play during their assessment sessions on a Sunday morning and Monday evenings as applicable. Our academy coaches have also been liaising with the leadership team to create a plan of action for the continuation of full academy in an indoor environment and more news of this will come in our next newsletter.

### JDC update

Our JDC groups have also been hard at work. Attleborough JDC have made it through their first rotation of 3 weeks with 9 girls in the sportshall at any one time. This has had a positive outcome for the girls returning to play, many of whom have also been attending the pre academy sessions. In addition to this, we have started discussions about Aylsham JDC returning to play in just a few weeks' time. But it was the launch of Norwich JDC on Saturday

3 October that was the big move on this front over the past two weeks, mobilising over 100 girls who signed up to the first 3 weeks' sessions.

### **Great news!**

During all this we also received a delivery of PPE and sanitising equipment over the value of £1000 from last years' National League sponsor, Pink Office. This has enabled us to keep teams topped up with sanitiser, our balls always squeaky clean and our coaches protected during these times.

### Norwich League and senior club

Sadly, after the government announcement on 22 September, we were forced to review the Norwich League for seniors and are waiting on confirmation regarding the transition of the league from indoors to outdoors. With our indoor facilities having been booked and paid for, the announcement came as a huge surprise and our leadership team have been reviewing the best course of action. When we have further details we will work to mobilise our senior squads and coaches to returning to play.

### Big wins

We now have over 250 athletes now returning to play netball at our club – a huge win as far as mobilising netball is concerned and I hope you can join me in congratulating the leadership team on achieving this. But we appreciate we still have a long way to go and we continue to develop our processes, communications and actions to ensure that we can get our club fully functioning before too long.

### A reminder of the protocols

Pre-session

If an NUNC member develops Covid-19 symptoms (a new and continuous cough, temperature or a loss/change in sense of smell or taste) PRIOR to attending a Norfolk United session, you **MUST NOT** attend. Please ensure to inform NHS Test and Trace, obtain a test, inform your coach and the Norfolk United Covid Officer — nunccovidofficer@gmail.com

Post-session

If an NUNC member develops Covid-19 symptoms within 48 hours of attending a session run by Norfolk United, you must inform NHS Test and Trace, obtain a test, inform your coach and the Norfolk United Covid Officer — <a href="mailto:nunccovidofficer@gmail.com">nunccovidofficer@gmail.com</a>

You **WILL NOT** be allowed to attend any sessions until either 10 days have elapsed, or you can provide evidence of a negative test.

### A positive test

If you are able to receive a test and get a positive result please inform Norfolk United Covid Officer – <a href="mailto:nunccovidofficer@gmail.com">nunccovidofficer@gmail.com</a> who will then work with your regular sessional coach to inform any of your team mates who may wish to isolate or receive a test. Please be aware that if you have a test within 48 hours attending a session that comes back positive, you are obliged to inform NHS Test and Trace and the Norfolk United Covid Officer - <a href="mailto:nunccovidofficer@gmail.com">nunccovidofficer@gmail.com</a> immediately, regardless of symptoms.

### **During a session**

Please ensure to sanitise frequently and abide by the government social distancing protocol at all times.

If you feel unwell or think you are developing symptoms, identify this with your coach immediately.

Any u16's, we will contact parents immediately and request collection within 30 minutes.

### Post session

Please keep us as up to date as you can regarding personal symptoms or symptoms that may develop within your family/contacts as soon as possible. This will help to ensure we keep everyone safe.
