6. Refreshments

A post match buffet for the Players will be served in the Social Club shortly after the trophy presentations in three separate sittings. The cost to be agreed between Newtown AFC and FAW.

The meal for a total of 120 people (3 sittings x 40 people) is to be supplied for players and match officials in the Players Lounge after each of the games at 1:00pm, 3:00pm and 5:00pm.

Wristbands will be provided to the coaches on the day. The host club should provide refreshments for purchase for spectators.

A buffet for VIP's to serve 20 people is to be served in the Hospitality Suite from 12:30pm.

7. Match Duration/Extra Time/Penalties

Under 12 - 2 x 30 minutes *(Extra Time 10 minutes, 2 x 5 minutes)*

Under 14 - 2 x 35 minutes *(Extra Time 20 minutes, 2 x 10 minutes)*

Under 16 - 2 x 40 minutes *(Extra Time 20 minutes, 2 x 10 minutes)*

If the match ends in a draw after the scheduled amount of time as stated above, Extra Time will be played. If the scores are still level after extra time the match will be decided from the taking of kicks of the penalty mark in accordance with International Board Decision.

At the end of the match the Cup and Mementoes will be presented to both teams.

9. 9 v 9 Pitch

Newtown Football Club are asked to set the pitch up for the U12 Final in accordance with the pitch requirements for 9v9 football, using the goals, which were provided by the FAW. This should be completed by 10am.

10. Substitutes

Each team will be entitled to name up to seven substitutes, all of whom may be used in the match with rolling subs permitted. The names must be included on the team sheets, which must be handed to the referee in his dressing room, at least 60 minutes prior to the kick off.

11. Financial Arrangements

The invoice should also include the cost for player refreshments, gatemen, stewards and any other costs incurred by the club. A match statement will be provided which should be completed and returned to this office, together with the gross gate receipts within 7 days of the match.

12. Medical Arrangements

The FAW have arranged Paramedics for medical treatment of players, officials and spectators.

13. Tickets

On the day, participating clubs and match officials will be provided with tickets as follows:

- a) Players Buffet Wristbands: Quantity = 20
- b) Referee Wristbands Quantity = 1 each

15. Stewarding


Stewarding is to be provided by the host club as considered appropriate. Police will not be required.
