The Role:

- Maintain a sound relationship with other senior coaches
- Align technical strategy across players for future development and success
- Overseeing and managing individual development plans for players
- Liaising with support staff including medical
- Identify development needs of current players

- Report to the committee monthly including on field performance, injury management and player development strategies
- Be an integral part of Junior coaching seminars or strategy sessions
- Offer technical support or advise to Junior coaches if requested

About you:

To be considered for this role you will need to have:

- Extensive coaching experience (Level 2 Coach preferred)
- Smart rugby accredited or be prepared to obtain qualification prior to the 2019 season
- Working with Children clearance (as some players maybe under 18 years of age)
- Ability to articulate how you would develop a rugby program and improve the Club performance on and off the field
- Communicate with the committee on issues that impact on the Club i.e. training, schedules, team, individual players and changes
- Ability to lead a group of support staff
- Effective communication will be essential
