- The owners of the club also took the decision to lay a state of the art 4G pitch back in 2013 at the cost of £350,000 to enable our youth teams to train and play matches in a stadium experience, something that would not have been possible with a grass pitch. PRE-SEASON & REGISTRATIONS

- Your child's training night will be available at Registration.
- We would like all players registered at the earliest opportunity to ensure kits and teams are in place ready for the start of the season.
