(Wiki) The club was established in 1889. They were founder members of the West Sussex League in 1896 and were placed in the Senior Division. They remained in the league until joining the Sussex County League in 1949. When the league gained a second division in 1952, they were placed in Division One. In 1957–58 they won Division One, and retained the title the following season.

In 1965–66 Arundel finished second-from-bottom of Division One and were relegated to Division Two. However, they made an immediate return to Division One as Division Two runners-up the following season, and went on to finish as Division One runners-up in 1968–69.

This was repeated in the mid-1970s, when relegation in 1975–76 was followed by promotion in 1976–77, a season in which the club also won the Division Two Cup. Another relegation in 1982–83 resulted in another immediate return to Division One as Division Two runners up in 1983–84, with the club going on to win their third title in 1986–87, also claiming the league's Challenge Cup. In 1997–98 they finished bottom of Division One and were relegated to Division Two. Two seasons later they finished as runners-up in Division Two to earn promotion back to Division One.

In 2003–04 Arundel won the Challenge Cup, and in 2008–09 finished as Division One runners-up. In 2015 the league was renamed the Southern Combination, with Division One becoming the Premier Division. The 2018–19 season saw Arundel finish second-from-bottom of the Premier Division, resulting in relegation to Division One for the 2019-20 campaign.

Arundel 2-2 Oakwood 9 November 1991 Sussex County League Division 1

It was a case of shared kit and shared points at Mill Road where Oakwood had to borrow Arundel's yellow and red strip as the referee was unhappy about a clash of colours. Oakwood had travelled with their white strip but Arundel's "red and white trim" contained too much white for the referee's satisfaction. Honours finished even for the second time this season but Oakwood could count themselves hard done by after an encouraging first half which saw them take the lead with a George Smith goal

Oaks showed plenty at determination and were getting forward in numbers. Peter Frake at right back was always ready to support the attack and both Dave Palmer and Keith Hurren were winning their respective aerial battles. Both sides had early chances with Oaks keeper Kevin Robbins getting down quickly to save at the foot of the post while, at the other end. Gary Chandler turned well before sending in a low cross which came back to the unmarked Palmer whose shot was deflected wide of a gaping goal. Despite enjoying the lion's share of the possession. Oakwood looked vulnerable to the counter attack down their right flank and twice Mark Richardson was called upon to make important tackles.

The deadlock was broken on 32 minutes following a good move which began on the halfway line. Peter Brackpool fed Frake whose driven cross was headed home past Paul Bennett by Smith. Oaks held their lead to the interval thanks to a goal-line clearance by Frake on the stroke of half time, but instead of being able to build on their first half showing they found themselves all square within five minutes of the restart.

There was an element of bad luck as the ball came back off Palmer, striking Brackpool before running, kindly to Danny Levy who suddenly found himself with only Robbins to beat. For the next 20 minutes a stale-mate developed before manager Tony Reece took a gamble and put on Keith Browning who has struggled to overcome the effects of a knee injury, as an extra midfielder. Browning made' an immediate impact. forcing a corner after a one-two with Smith, and Oakwood's best chance of the half fell to Paul Green who ran through only to hit his shot straight at Bennett. A second substitution saw Stuart Whelan replace John Wilmott but almost immediately Oakwood fell behind. Palmer was beaten on the left and bouncing cross was met by Levy diving low to head home at the far post. Twice in. quick succession Arundel cleared on the goal-line and twice Oakwood appealed for a penalty. The second claim was up held but hearts sank as Bennett saved Frake's spot kick. But the referee ordered it to be re-taken as Bennett had moved and Frake kept his cool to earn Oaks a point with just 10 minutes left.
