Our visitors

Dorking Wanderers were formed in 1999 and have a local connection with us having initially played in the Crawley and District League before switching to the West Sussex League where they progressed swiftly through the levels. After winning the Premier Division in 2006-07 they were promoted to the Sussex County League third division with another fairly rapid rise through the ranks



During this part of their history we have two previous encounters with them, in the 2011-12 season, resulting in a 3-3 draw away and a 2-5 loss here at Tinsley Lane.

In 2014-15 the Wanderers achieved promotion to the Isthmian League (Division One South) after finishing second to Littlehampton Town.

Further success followed for the club as they made it to the play-offs in the their first season but had to wait another year before making it up to the Isthmian Premier after beating Corinthian Casuals in the play-off final on penalties.

In 2018-19 the Wanderers won the Premier Division by an impressive 22 points thereby earning promotion to the National League South. More success followed quickly with qualification for the play-offs where they reached the semi-finals.

The reserve team has played in the Suburban League and the Combined Counties League before joining the Macron SCFL for this season.
