

CLUB FUN DAY

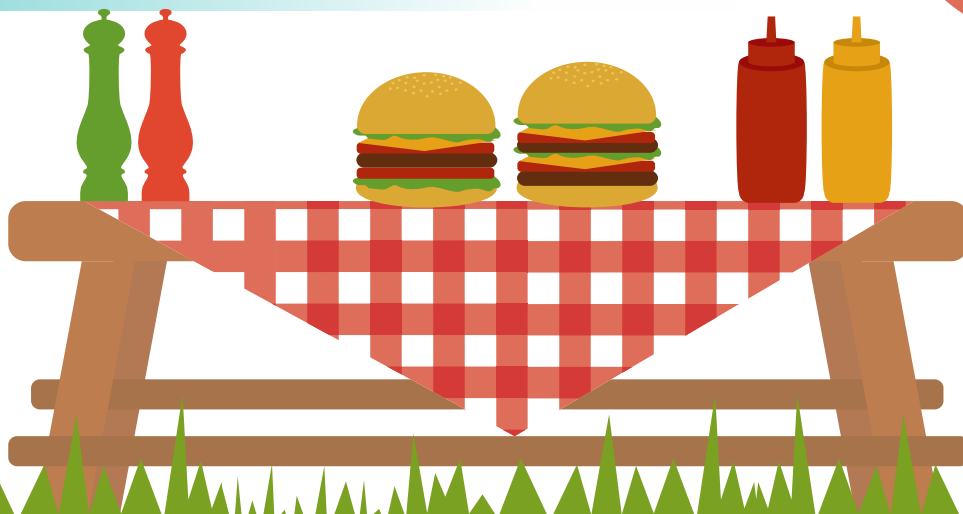
SATURDAY 6th SEPTEMBER 2014
