KFCC 2019 FUNTASY CRICKET



Funtasy cricket has returned for the 2019 season, it's not too late to enter!

Andrew Wild will no doubt be defending his crown against all comers. Let us make this season even more competitive than last season.

All players playing for any of our sides where the results are entered onto our "play-cricket" site are eligible for selection for any team that can be entered.

To enter a team the fee is £10 per team (£5 for any colt that enters a team). You can enter **MORE** than One team!

Your team budget is £70,000,000 and every player that potentially can be selected has been valued. This season I have based valuation on performance last season adjusted where I feel this is not a true reflection on the player. Obviously, this is likely to start debate without a ball being bowled as the vast majority of players have had their value reduced! Consequently, some players appear to be a bargain. You can decide who the bargains are.

The team must consist of four batsman, four bowlers, two all-rounders and one keeper. Each player has been given a classification. If you do not agree with your classification, you can appeal to me but I will probably choose to ignore your objection!

There are six transfer windows where you can change a maximum of two players, the window dates are self-evident from the web pages.

Bank Transfer using details given on the Club Registration form using your surname and as much of Funtasy that will fit as a reference.

Cash to Martin Pope ,Nick Claus or Nick Cocks (provided the Nicks agree)

Cheques made payable to "Kelvedon and Feering Cricket Club"

The instructions are straightforward

Once you have selected your team press "save team" the system takes you to "My Teams" page – **DO NOT select "pay for teams"**.

At this point you can either "add" another team or exit back to home page. Your team has been saved and will be "authorised" by the administrator (me) as quickly as possible and the team will show up on the web site.

This enables me to track team payments and allow for a lower fee for participating colts.

Looking forward to some lighthearted debate and banter for the season, the winner will be presented with the special trophy at the end of the season at the relevant awards ceremony.
