Annual Two Counties Fixture



KFCC v Two Counties Over 50's XI, Thursday, June 6th

The weather was kind to us and the annual fixture against a Two Counties over 50s XI went ahead without an interruption, no mean feat given the recent weather! Here is the Two Counties web-site report of the fixture:

Two Counties Over 50's 209-8 (Tim Porter 85 Nick Meakin 57 Alex Parsons 3-28)

Kelvedon & Feering XI 210-5 (Phil Tomkins 65 Stuart Stobbs 40 not out Simon Sergeant 2-44)

Kelvedon & Feering XI won by 5 wickets

The last 10 overs of the second innings turned this match from quite a sedate, comfortable Two Counties victory to a thrilling last ball win for Kelvedon & Feering. The Kelvedon reply got off to a decent start thanks to a patient 65 from Phil Tomkins. The first two partnerships had added 102 runs before Tomkins fell to the bowling of Simon Sargeant with the score on 132 in the 33rd over. With the required run rate now over 6 runs per over, Kelvedon's cause looked lost. However, Stuart Stobbs and Alex Parsons made the Two Counties pay for over indulging at the tea table. In less than six overs these two set about running the fielders ragged as they plundered 48 runs. Despite the loss of Parsons, 26 off 21 balls, Stobbs, 40 not out off 40 balls, guided the hosts to victory with a leg bye off the final delivery.

Earlier, the Two Counties had put 209 runs on the scoreboard from their allotted 45 overs. This total relied much on a second wicket partnership of 116 between Tim Porter and Nick Meakin. Meakin's hard hitting 57 came to a close in the 28th over with the score on 136 whilst a rather more patient Porter saw the score up to 174 before he became the fourth wicket to fall. Porter's dismissal brought about a flurry of wickets before John Gallant's cameo at number 9, 17 not out off 7 balls helped to push the Two Counties total above 200. Alex Parsons 3-28 and Phil Tomkins 2-44 had done well to restrict the visitor's score.
