
COMPUTER SUITE

DELIVERING WELLBEING IN BEWSEY AND DALLAM

a partnership that is committed to real change

At the end of August 2013, residents were asked about what they wanted to see improved across Bewsey and Dallam . This was followed up by an event in September 2013 attended by a range of groups and organisations with a vested interest in the area.

The findings of both exercises are being pulled together into a plan which will be delivered over the next three years. We are eager to see change happening and below are **some** of the changes that you will see over the coming months:

YOU SAID you wanted to see improvements to

Dallam Recreational ground. To begin the transformation of the recreational ground, we will be replacing the perimeter boundary and planting a new tree line. We are working with partners to upgrade the existing pitches and include a football pitch

Facilities for young people: Funding has been secured to site a Multi Use Games Area (MUGA) on Dallam Recreational Ground. Signage and notice boards will be established at the Recreational Ground.

Bewsey Meadows. Residents and groups wanted to see Bewsey Meadows improved. We are submitting a bid to WREN for funding to do just that. We are working closely with the Friends of Bewsey Park to learn from them how they developed Bewsey Park as the community asset it now is.

Sankey Valley Park. We are working closely with Warrington Borough Council to refresh the existing gateways into the Park.

Molyneux Triangle. Alongside Golden Gates Housing Trust proposals to develop 'the triangle' at the rear of the properties is well under way. Residents affected by the proposals have been asked for their views on the proposed improvements.

Support for local people to gain employment. GGHT have launched their new Bewsey IT Suite (B.I.T.S) – all are welcome. Priestly College and Warrington Collegiate will be delivering courses for local residents.

GGHT and Warrington Borough Council have jointly funded an employment engagement officer to work with employers to secure job opportunities, work placements and volunteer opportunities. The new post holder will take up post at the end of March 2014

We will be sharing our wider plans with residents and local groups over the coming months and will be attending community meetings and events to keep everyone up to date with developments.

We do hope that you will lend your support to the range of proposals we will be putting into place over the coming years.
