Royals bring down the Abbey

ROYALS RFC got their long-awaited revenge over returning Reading Abbey with an impressive 38-19 victory on Saturday.

The match was Abbey's third sortie to 'Fortress Grainville', with both previous meetings being resounding victories for the visitors – and once again they

deployed an accomplished squad including several first teamers.

Jersey Reds lock Jerry Sexton had no game commitments, so led the Royals from the sideline for the first time this season.

The visitors started strongly, utilising their heavier pack with hard carries. This, coupled with quick ball at the breakdown, created space for the backs, and centre Jack Stevenson cut a good line to dot down on ten minutes. Mike Beckly convert-

Although the Royals put the visitors under pressure, Reading soon offloaded their way up the pitch for winger Ed House to finish in the corner.

This, however, proved to be the wake-up call the Royals needed, and a string of powerful rucks created space out wide. Fast-hands delivered the ball to Will Dawson, who rode one tackle before beating the opposition full-back on the outside to score in the corner. Jake Vautier slotted a tough conver-

Livewire Royals scrum-half Harrison Jukes was the next to score when he jinked past the guard at the breakdown and swerved the full-back on 35 minutes. Vautier was again on target from the tee.

Abbey replied, with volatile flanker and man of the match Matt Eldridge crashing over. Beckly converted and Reading

The Royals emptied their bench on the resumption which ultimately proved decisive, with the visitors not scoring a point in the second period.

Royals' first-time hooker Sam Dillon formed a wedge with Tom Wright and crashed over on 49 minutes. The score went unconverted.

The Royals kept the pressure up, and on 52 minutes a moment of brilliance from wing -turned-centre Daniel Pozzo turned up the heat. Facing four defenders, Pozzo chipped ahead, caught on the bounce, sidestepped the last man and touched down. Jukes added the

As Abbey tired, Royals continued to impress with power and pace. Slick handling from Nick Kearns fed debutant Adam Le Seeleur on the rightwing. Brought on ten minutes prior, Le Seeleur raced down the 15 metre channel and fended off an attempted tackle to slide into the corner with five minutes to play.

Royals were still not done and Kearns carried hard to the gain-line before popping to marauding prop Cameron Quérée, who crashed through the defence before releasing ellusive centre Kirk Wisdom. Leaving one defender for dead with his trademark side-step he then out-paced the remaining Abbey defenders to score under the sticks. Jukes converted with the final act of the game to

round off a 38-19 victory . Royals officials thanked sponsors Dominion, Baker and Partners and Liberation Breweries for their support.
