Covid Players and Officials Guidance – April 2021

- If you think you have any COVID-19 symptoms prior to matches or training. Stay home, let us know and don't take part, follow the Gov't guidance on self-isolating
- Travel to matches or training on your own. Car sharing is not allowed unless the occupants are members of the same family or household.
- Please limit the time spent congregating at the ground before and after the cricket activity
- Changing rooms will remain out of action, if you are playing or training please come changed and ready to play. Wear a face covering when accessing the Clubhouse toilets
- For all senior games, players and officials should park and leave their kit on in the designated areas on the playing fields (football side of the ground)
- If the weather conditions prevent play during the game, players and officials should return to their cars until such time as play can resume or the game is abandoned
- Use own equipment throughout where possible and clean bat when leaving field of play
- Bring your own food and drink, including your tea and don't share drinks bottles
- Bring your own hand sanitiser to the game
- Players to remain socially distanced at all times (wicket keepers and slip fielders at 1m plus) The Rule of 6 (or as a group made up of two households) should be observed off the field?
- Hygiene breaks in play are required every 6 overs or 20 minutes for non-match play activities.
- No sweat or saliva is to be applied to the ball at any time.
- Social distancing should be maintained during wicket celebrations and drinks breaks. No handshakes, hugging, fist bumping or high five's!
- Batters are to run on separate sides of the track and not within 2m of the bowler or other batter
- Ball to be returned directly to the bowler (on full or rolled along ground)
- Players to ensure that any drinks, sweaters or other paraphernalia to be placed at least 1m from the boundary edge where possible
- All players and officials to submit contact details for the purposes of NHS Test and Trace using the QR Code
- Captains, please remind the players of the guidance before each game
